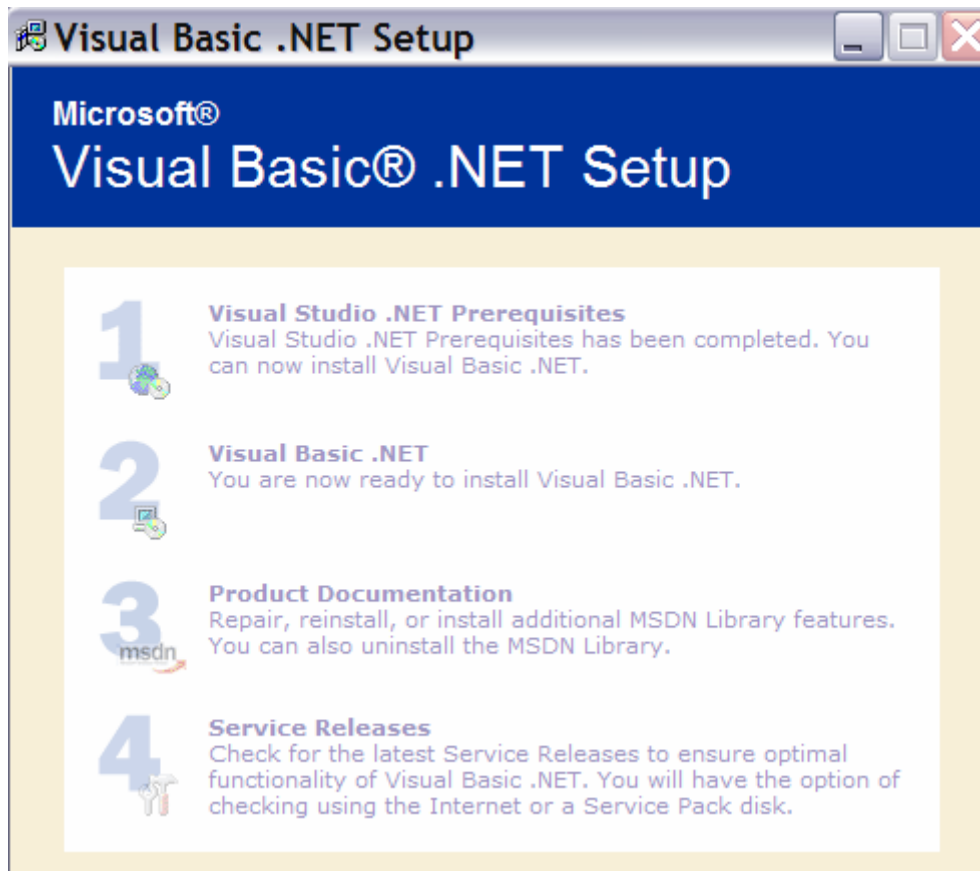


DISCLAIMER: These instructions assume you have installed software before. They do not show every window and question you will see. READ the screen for complete instructions.

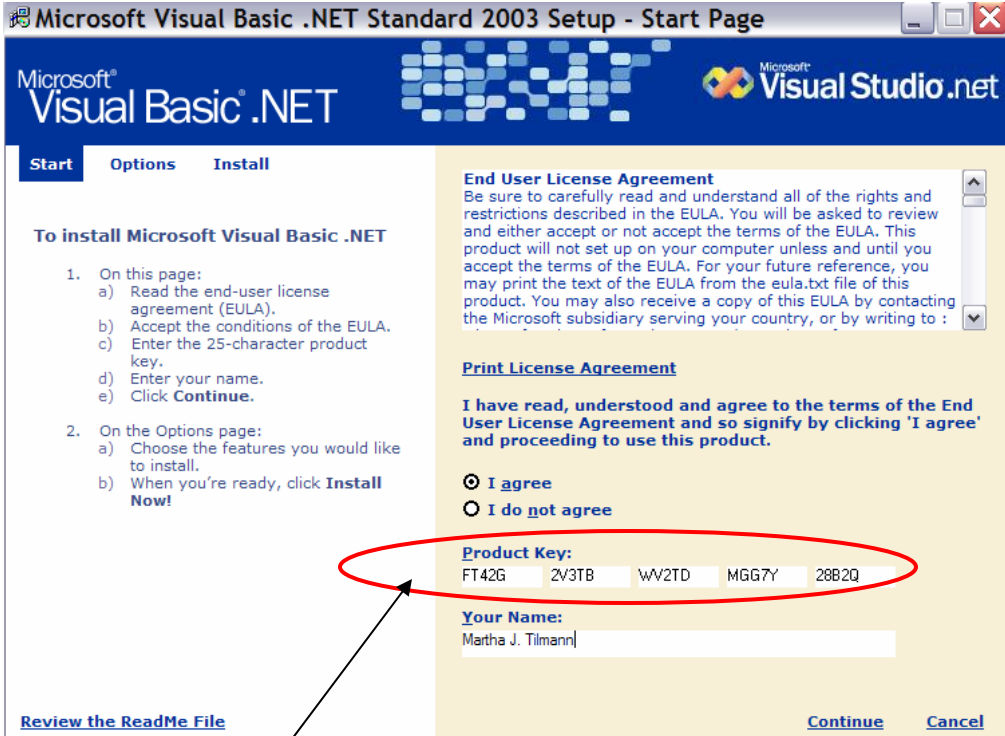
Five discs come in your packet: “Prerequisites,” Disc 1 “Insert First,” Disc 1, 2, and 3 “msdn Library”

- I. Put Disc 1 “Insert First” into your drive. This window appears.



1. Visual Studio .NET Prerequisites verifies that your system is acceptable for installing VB.NET. *Do this if it indicates your system is not ready.* CD “Prerequisites” supports this option.
2. Visual Basic .NET actually installs the software. *Do this first.* This requires only “Disc 1 Insert First” which is already in the drive at this time.
3. Product Documentation allows you to load the MSDN libraries. *Do this if you have ample room on your hard drive.* This requires Disc 1, 2, and 3 of “msdn Library” CDs. If you do not have room to load this locally, you’ll need to have Internet access to get the VB language and .NET support you need.
4. Service Releases goes to the Internet to get the latest security releases for your computer. *Do this.*

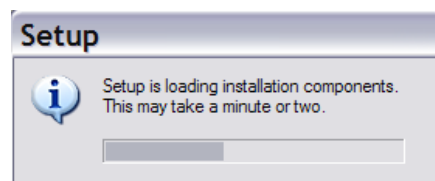
II. Once you begin to install VB.NET (#2 above) you will see a series of windows. Read them and answer appropriately. For example, here you want to mark “I agree” to the license agreement. Then type in the number from the gold label on the CD packet.



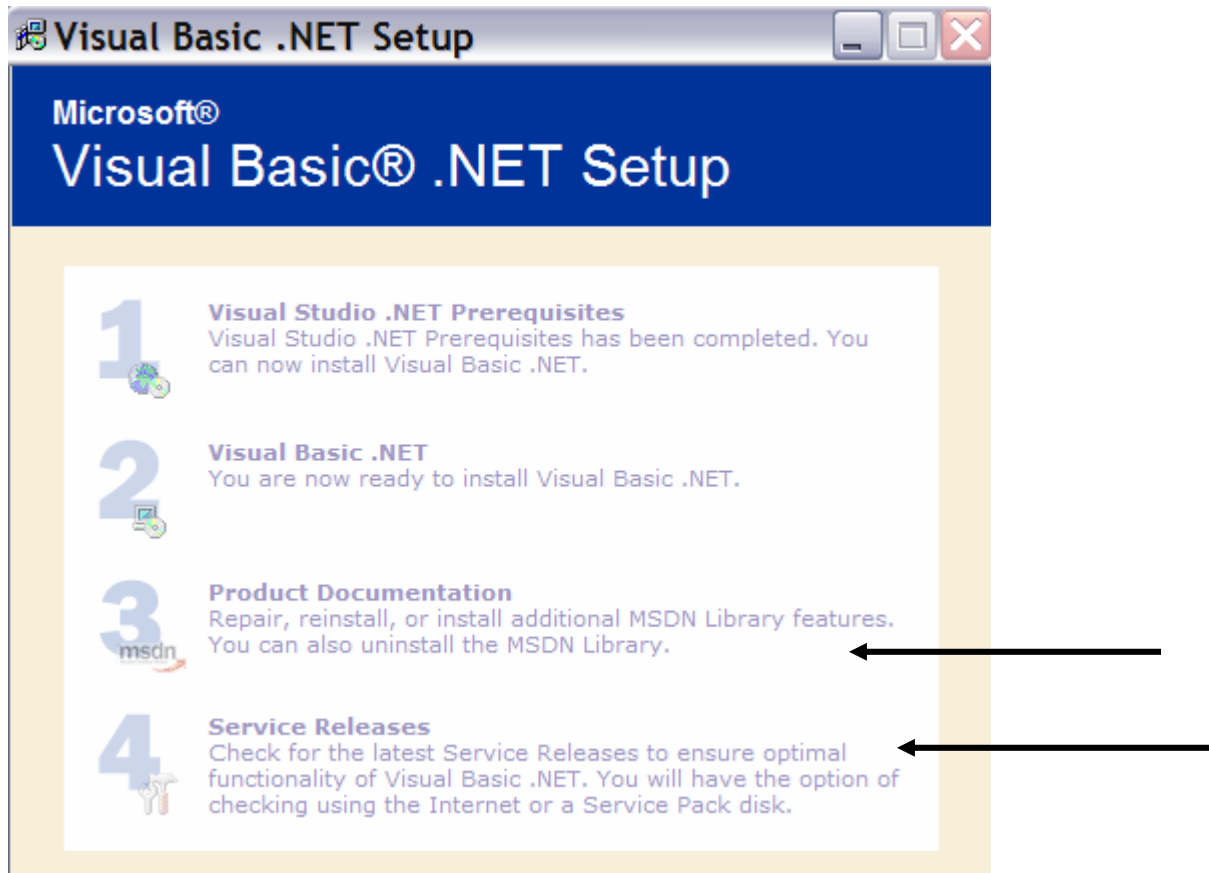

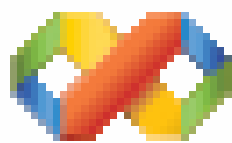
Various other status windows will appear to keep you informed on the progress. For example the following two shown here:
